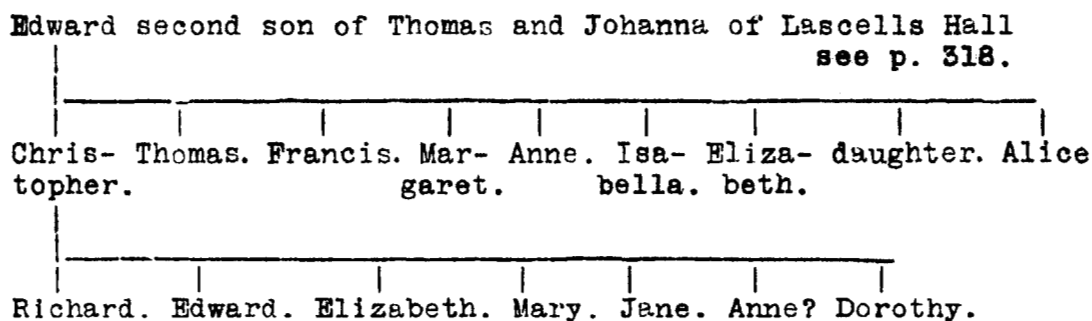
THE YORKSHIRE BEAUMONTS - THE CALTON FAMILY

EDDWARD BEAUMONT, of Calton, was the second son of Thomas and Johanna, of Lascells Hall. He was under age in 1556 and died in 1596, buried at Calton. He married at Mirfield 3rd August, 1574, Elizabeth, daughter of Christopher Hopton of Armley. She was buried at Mirfield 24th July, 1588. Issue:

I. Christopher, heir.

II. Thomas, of Selby, baptised at Mirfield 23rd February 1580, died 1615, and buried in Calton Church.

III. Francis, buried at Mirfield 24th November 1578.

IV. Margaret, buried at Mirfield 26th April 1580.

V. Anne, baptised at Mirfield 7th April 1577, she married Michael Portington of Portington, Esquire in 1612. They had four children.

VI. Isabella, baptised at Mirfield 17th August 1578, married Richard Darley of Butterscombe.

VII. Elizabeth, baptized at Mirfield 10th December 1581.

VIII. Daughter, buried at Mirfield 8th April, 1583.

IX. Alice, baptised at Mirfield 25th December 1586, married Thomas Green, of Barnby.

CHRISTOPHER BEAUMONT of Millington and Calton, baptised at Mirfield 7th August, 1575, buried at Calton 16th April, 1613, he married 20th October 1612, Elizabeth daughter and heiress of Robert Day, of Elmsall, Yorks. Issue:

I. Richard, heir.

II. Edward, alive in 1629.

III. Elizabeth, alive in 1630.

IV. Mary, married 19th December, 1630, William Thornbrough.

V. Jane, married, 1629, Henry Leeds.

VI. Anne.

VII. Dorothy, of Sutton, married in 1627 or 1630, Marmaduke Poole.
